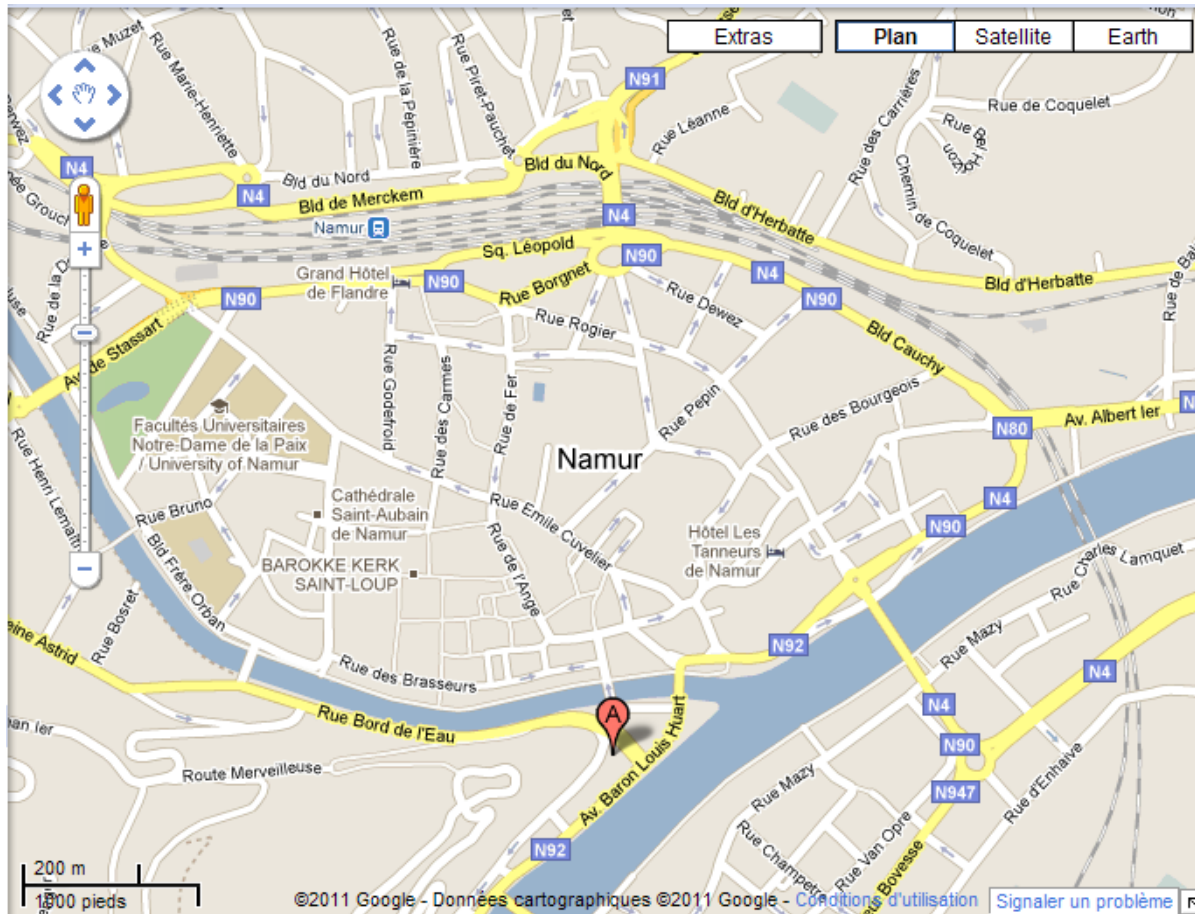


Travel Directions to the Walloon Parliament



**WALLOON PARLIAMENT, SAINT-GILLES BUILDING,
RUE NOTRE-DAME, 1, NAMUR**

BY CAR

FROM THE E411 HIGHWAY, BRUXELLES-ARLON

- Take exit 14 to Bouge;
- Follow the direction to Namur (on your right when coming from Brussels);
- Follow the road, pass in front of the Regional Healthcare Center until reaching a traffic light beneath a railway bridge;
- Turn left;
- Follow the Meuse river. You see a bridge crossing the Meuse on your left. Continue until seeing another bridge on a river, slightly on your left;
- This is the bridge on the Sambre river. Cross it;
- At the traffic lights just after the bridge, you will see the Parliament. It is in front of you, slightly on the right. The entrance is on the building side facing the fortified Citadel.



FROM THE E42 HIGHWAY, MONS-LIÈGE

- At the E42-E411 interchange, follow the direction to Luxembourg;
- Once on the E411, follow the instruction as indicated above.

By train

The train journey to Namur/Namen from Brussels Central Station takes about 1 hour and a train departs every half an hour.

The train that departs at 07:37 from Brussels Central Station Arrives in Namur at 08:39.

The train that departs at 08:07 from Brussels Central Station Arrives in Namur at 09:09.

FROM THE NAMUR STATION it takes approximately 15 minutes to walk to the Walloon Parliament

- Exit the station to the city centre. Go left;
- Pass in front of the C&A shop, then follow the street « rue de Fer »;
- Once in the street « rue de l'Ange », pass in front of the Inno shop;
- At the « place d'Armes », follow the street that crosses the river Sambre. On the bridge, you will see the Parliament.

By bus

THE CLOSEST BUS STOP IS AT BARON LOUIS HUART AVENU at approximately 1 minute walking distance to the Walloon Parliament

There are a large number of buses that stop near the Walloon Parliament including bus 51 (stop Place L'ilon), bus 9 (stop NAMUR Place d'armes), bus 8 (stop NAMUR Place d'armes) bus 4 (stop NAMUR pont de France / Avenue Baron Louis Huart).

From these stops it is only a few minutes walking to the Walloon Parliament.

For the train times mentioned above from Brussels Central Station it is the easiest is to take:

Arriving in Namur at 08:39 by train --> bus 4 at 08:47 in the direction of Profondeveille/Mont. which arrives at 08:51 at the stop NAMUR Pont de France / Avenue Baron Louis Huart

Arriving in Namur at 09:09 by train --> bus 4 at 09:17 in the direction of Profondeveille/Mont. arrives at 09:21 at the stop NAMUR Pont de France / Avenue Baron Louis Huart

from there it is one minute walking to the Walloon Parliament (see map on page 1).
